CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD

Liturgically, we now see green, and we tell the children, "Green is for growing time." The children here have a growing relationship with Jesus. They want to know "Who is God?" The people of Israel wanted to know "Who are you, Jesus?". Both questions He answers in this one parable. Jn 10:3b-16 "[The Good Shepherd] calls his own sheep by name [...] I came that they might have life [...] I lay down my life for the sheep. [...] I am the Good Shepherd..." The child who hears this may know already or she may wonder for a period of time who these happy sheep might be. But once that point is reached of independently realizing who exactly it is that the Good Shepherd knows and loves in such a way, it is then that without a doubt the wonder only increases! 
