WORKPLACE ACCESSIBILITY



Ecumenical Log Drivers:

Rt. Rev. Bruce Myers, OGS (Anglican Bishop of Quebec) In the past century the ecumenical movement has made extraordinary efforts in healing the wounds of division in the the church. Did you know... There are 25 First Nations reserves located in Treaty 4 territory in Saskatchewan and all of them are within the boundaries of the Archdiocese of Regina. The reserve system is governed by the Indian Act of 1876 which was never part of the treaty promises. First Nations agreed to share the land with the newcomers. They did not agree to have it divided into tracts of land called reserves. The Nehiyawak, Anishinabek, Dakota, Lakota, and Nakota First Nations peoples lived in this territory for thousands of years.




