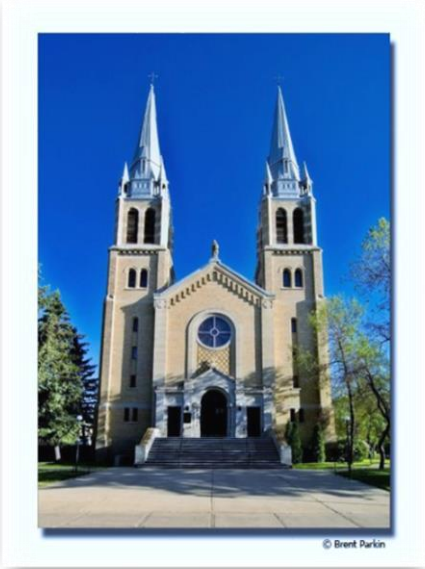

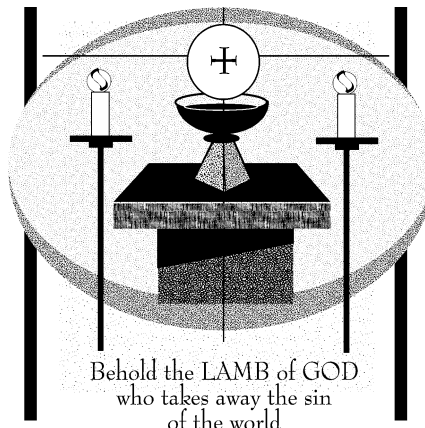

The Government of Canada is asking for input by **January 27** on their proposal to expand the criteria for euthanasia in Canada so that

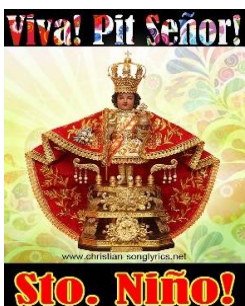
