Did you know that... in 1493 Pope Alexander VI issued the first of four orders that granted most of North and South America to Spain, the kingdom that had sponsored Columbus's voyage of the preceding year. These orders helped shape the political and legal arguments that have come to be referred to as the ‘Doctrine of Discovery’ which was used to justify the colonization of the Americas in the 16th century. In return, the Spanish were expected to convert the Indigenous peoples of the Americas to Christianity.

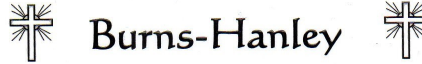
