Children's Liturgy of The Word – The Archdiocesan protocols require two adults to be present when children are gathered to share the Sunday readings, reflections, and prayers. One person is asked to lead the session, the other is a support person. Volunteers enter a covenant agreement with the Parish and are required to obtain a Police Records Check, including a Vulnerable Sector Check. The Parish will reimburse the \$10 fee for these checks. Watch for volunteer sign-up in August.
