





Fr. Dan will be away from Thurs., May 30th to Tue., June 4th inclusive.





CPE helps to form and develop one's self for service, which is our primary tool in caring for others. If you are interested in developing your skills in soul-care, whether for professional development, seminary credit, or as a way to develop your personalized learning goals, CPE is a formational learning opportunity. An internationally recognized program, CPE teaches skills and competencies for professional spiritual care and can lead to certification with Canadian Association of Spiritual Care (CASC/ ACSS). Students gather with a small peer group for a full day on Tuesdays and spiritual care clinical practice opportunities will take place one day per week at Santa Maria + students' current ministry sites. Group and individual supervision will be provided by Erika Mills, CASC Certified Supervisor-Educator. CPE accepts up to 6 students per learning site. Tuition is \$1350 plus required student membership and insurance with CASC/ ACSS, approximately \$200. Applications are due July 1, 2024.
