





#### Young Adult Small Groups




#### TF237: Middle Earth, Magesterium, and Modernity - Part 1

When booking an appointment for vaccination, please keep the following in mind:

• Telephone booking is for use only by those currently eligible to receive the vaccine

• For all other covid or vaccine-related inquires, you are asked to use 811

• Once you become eligible, you will remain eligible even after other age groups open up

When the time comes for you to book your appointment, please have the following on hand:

- Saskatchewan health card
- Cell phone number or Email address

Confirmation of booking will be sent by text or

email. You will also receive a notification 24 hours before your appointment. If your appointment time changes, you will also be notified.

During the booking process, you will have the opportunity to select a vaccination clinic closest to you.
