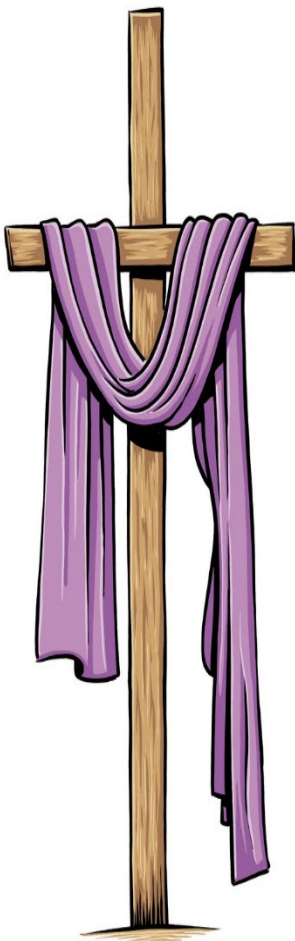

Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

Spring is slowly peeking around the corner.....let us hope that it keeps peeking and does not hide its face again!

The exciting news is the start of the next phase of our Rebuilding Campaign! The first phase made sure that the church is accessible to all who wish to enter it: a new elevator, new accessible washrooms. This next phase will be of particular interest to the rest of us, as it will involve the long-overdue and necessary renovation of the Hall and the washrooms, and the updating/fixing of essential infrastructure such as the sewers, power lines, and heating system.

Most of you will have picked up the information packages these last two Sundays. Attached to the packages you picked up at church are the pledge forms, with information about the cost of the renovation. The \$4 million estimate can be daunting; but we are off to a good start. We have \$500K on hand, thanks to donations to the initial campaign. Our job is to come up with the \$3.5m, so we can start the work. We inherited our magnificent church from generations past; our responsibility is to preserve what we have been given for our children and grandchildren --- the generations to come. The cathedral is over 100 years old; WE must make sure that it will still be standing 100 years from now.

The pledge forms show you various ways of making donations to the Campaign. You can give a lump sum, or pledge to give monthly over a number of years, however much you wish to give. No donation is too small.

For other important information: the Stations of the Cross continue every Friday of Lent, at 6:00 p.m. The Lenten Reconciliation will be on Saturday, April 5, at 9:45 a.m., after Mass. There will be several priests in attendance. On Palm Sunday, April 13, there will be the usual Masses at 9:00 & 11:00 a.m., and 7:00 p.m. Holy Thursday (April 17) service will be at 7:00 p.m., Good Friday (April 18) service is at 3:00 p.m., and Easter Vigil (April 19) at 8:30 p.m. Easter Sunday services will be at the usual 9:00 & 11:00 a.m., and 7:00 p.m.

From both nature and our faith, Easter and spring will bring with them the message of hope and renewal. THAT hope is what we need these days of so much political and economic upheaval, of so much conflict and war and famine in the world. We count our blessings and give thanks for what we have, as we reach out our hands to give and help as much as we can.

Now that our accounting process is back to normal in the office, we are able to keep you regularly up to date on our financial affairs. In January and February, offertory donations total \$ 69,556.05 not far from our expectations. Thank you for your continuing generosity, which keeps our doors open.

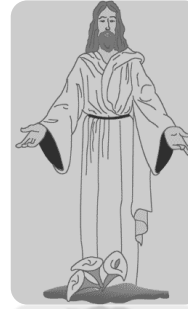

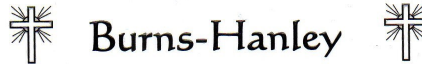
