Vatican II and Synodality with Dr. Catherine Clifford



During his study leave, he visited countless parishes and groups, connecting with priests, pastoral staff, and lay leaders while observing and learning how we "walk together" as a synodal church on mission. Most recently, he participated as a table facilitator at the 2nd Synodal Assembly in Rome in October. "How far did we progress on the synodal path, and how can we deepen our commitment to walking together in communion, participation, and mission?




