



#### SOCIAL JUSTICE AND DEVELOPMENT & PEACE FALL 2022

❖ As Catholic Christians we are all called to serve God's People in a variety of ways.



All are invited to meet Sunday, September 18 between the 9 and 11 a.m. Masses (10 a.m. to 10:50) in the basement.

The items listed here will be the discussion points.

- Since 1891, "Rerum Novarum" to the present day, there have been encyclicals, documents, and letters from Catholic leadership about the **Dignity of Work.** Is there interest in setting up a small business fair at the Cathedral on a Sunday before and after all three Masses? This would allow our parishioners to share with others their small business ventures. Registration to set up a table would be required, and cost would be a donation to the church. Minimum 10 businesses in order to go ahead.
- ❖ Encyclicals always include the Dignity of all Persons. Holy Rosary Cathedral parishioners have been slotted in for Saturday November 12, from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. to make sandwiches, then serve lunch to a downtown Saturday lunch program for people who are hard pressed to have enough money to buy food. We need minimum 8 volunteers. We will be following the directions from Nick from the Archdiocese as to how to do this. And, for one hour the following week (time to be determined), we will be doing a debriefing with Tashia from the Archdiocese to understand the dignity of all persons more deeply from the perspective of the Gospels.
- ❖ As in Jesus' time, all was shared equally among disciples. Common Destination of the World's Goods is a predominant theme in encyclicals, documents, and letters in the 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> centuries. We will hold a rummage sale Thursday November 24 to Sunday November 27th in support of refugee sponsorship. We need 20 to 25 volunteers – 5 to 6 each day.

Did you know... The Treaty 4 territory encompasses a vast portion of southern Saskatchewan and a western segment of Manitoba with 36 First Nations representing over 60,000 members in their jurisdiction. Treaty 4 includes major cities such as Regina, Moose Jaw, Swift Current, Weyburn, and Yorkton. Treaty 4 is one of five treaties negotiated between the Crown and First Nations in what is now the province of Saskatchewan. Treaty 2 was not negotiated in Saskatchewan but covers a small portion of land in the southeast corner of the province.


