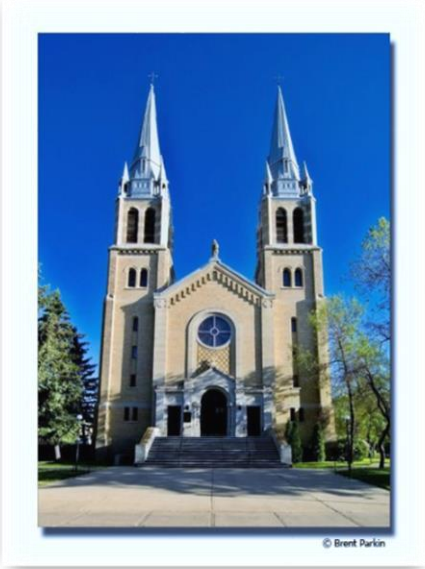

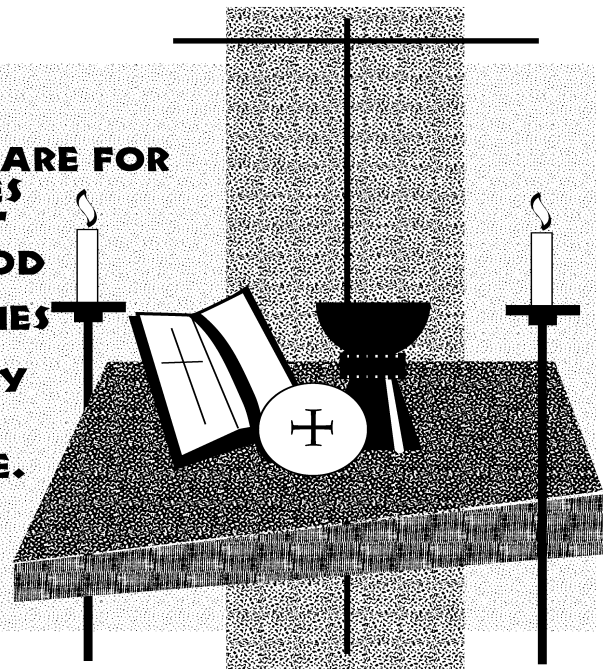

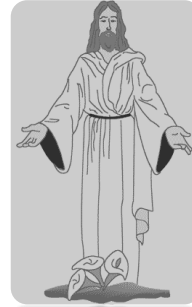

## Archbishop’s Appeal

Our readings for this Sunday remind us of God’s constant invitation for us to God’s eternal banquet. But like the guests who were invited in today’s gospel, we too sometimes decide to give more importance to our own concerns. The Lord invites us today to look at our own relationship with God. God desires to be in relationship with us and invites us time and time again to respond. We sometimes fail in our response. Like those in the parable who rejected the invitation, we get busy with our own agendas; we ignore God. Or, like the man who shows up improperly dressed, we have the wrong attitude. We may be smug, indifferent or insincere. We cast ourselves into the darkness when we refuse God’s offer of friendship.

Let us ask the Holy Spirit to help us become more aware of ways to pay attention to and say our yes to God’s invitation to friendship - the “eternal banquet”. One of the ways is our giving to the Archbishop’s Appeal which goes to further the good works God has entrusted to the church in the Archdiocese of Regina. 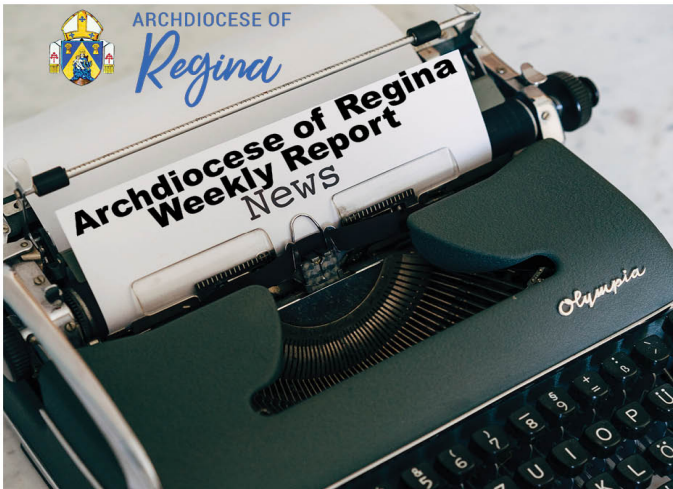
