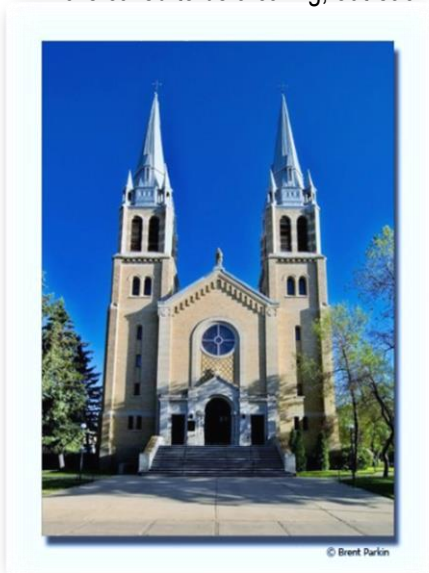

Am. 6:1, 4-7/1 Tm 6:11-16/ Lk 16: 19-31

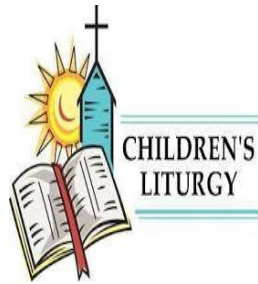
