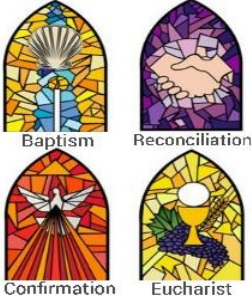
generosity will help us live "God-centered" lives and not "self-centered" lives.

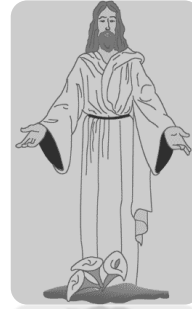

Dear parishioners and visitors,

It seems like just yesterday that we sent out our June newsletter, welcoming the start of summer. And now it is almost (but not yet!) Fall.

We hope you had a safe, relaxing summer and have stored many good memories of gatherings with friends and family.

Our June letter optimistically announced that the Steering Committee of the Rebuilding Campaign would be reviewing bids and signing on a construction company by mid-July to start work on the renovations in the Cathedral. The hope then was that the work would begin by the end of July. The reality was somewhat but not too far off. At the end of July, an agreement was signed with ICM (Independent Construction Management), the company that worked on the accessibility project in the Sacristy last winter.

Work should begin soon on Phase 1: the new elevator, washrooms, and the south exit stair. Please keep in mind the information in the June letter regarding the management of disruptions once the renovations begin. As the current elevator and washrooms beside it will be gone during the construction, the ushers at the Masses will lead you to alternate facilities. Your patience will be amply rewarded once the project is done, hopefully by the end of June 2024.

The Pandemic and current global political and natural tragedies have dramatically affected our economy, as we all know. One effect is the rise in the cost of our project from what was originally budgeted. The project team has looked at ways to reduce costs in order to get as close to the budget as possible. There is wisdom in the decision to proceed as planned with the work on the renovations. Phase 2, the Towers, will follow next year. There is no point in delaying essential repairs on our Cathedral as construction costs are bound to keep on rising down the road.

And for those who have so far donated towards the Rebuilding Campaign, it will be good to see their generosity in something concrete.

Our deepest gratitude to Archbishop Don and those who have worked tirelessly and for a long time on the Rebuilding Campaign, and the list is long. But for the moment, and in particular, we must thank John Dipple and Ray Plosker for their "hands-on" management and leadership on this renovation project.

Many of you will have heard of or will have seen on "social media", advertisements of the Candlelight Concerts to be performed in our Cathedral. FEVERUP, the company handling these highly successful concerts, has been putting them on in various cities across Canada and in Europe over the last few years; the majority of venues have been churches. October will see the first of them in Saskatchewan, starting in Saskatoon on the 26th. They are scheduled in our Cathedral on October 27, November 17 and 30, and December 14 and 15. The music featured will be from both the classical and the "pops" genres; they will travel with a group of musicians but will also have Regina musicians perform at times.

This is exciting news for us, allowing us to open our doors to many in the community who may never have been inside our beautiful Cathedral, an opportunity, once again, to be an integral part of the city's artistic culture. And we have the blessing of Archbishop Don to do so.

Another exciting event is coming up: OKTOBERFEST! This very popular evening will be back again this year, thanks to the energy and generosity of Tim LaBelle and his team. Date: October 14. Tickets: \$30 a person, now selling at Burns-Hanley and the parish office, until Sunday, October 8, in the cathedral entrance after every Mass. This is a chance to gather as a community and to have fun while contributing towards the maintenance of the Cathedral.

And yet another important event: Sacramental preparation for First Reconciliation starts on October 19 and ends on December 7. The Sacramental ceremony itself will be on December 8. For further information, please call the office at 306-565-0909.

Our financial picture: offertory collections in July were \$32,222 and in August \$25,371. Collections year-to-date: \$218,445, and the prorated budget to date: \$253,333. The offertory collection shortfall in our budget as of end of August is \$32,488, which is worrying, but we have to be hopeful: we have three months to make up the deficit by the end of the year. As always, we are grateful for your generosity, which keeps us solvent.

A big request: we are in need of volunteers for our various ministries: Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, Altar Servers, Ushers, Children's Liturgy assistant, RCIA Co-ordinator and team members, Music Choir. For further information, please speak to Fr. Dan or contact the office (306-565-0909). Thank you to those who have already stepped up, but we do need more assistance in these areas. Thank you for considering to give some of your time and gifts to the spiritual life of our parish community.

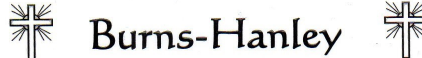

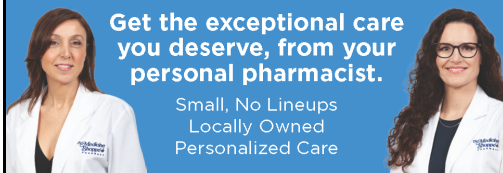
