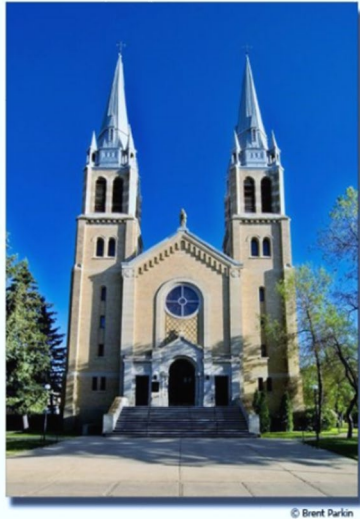

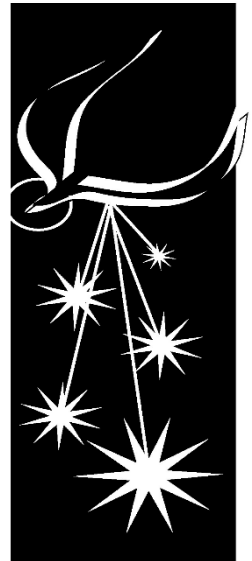

2023 PARISH FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The parish financial statements for 2023 were recently finalized and the required Charity Return was filed with the Canada Revenue Agency. Our parish ended 2023 with a small surplus of \$3,300 in our operating fund based on donations and other revenue of \$442,470 and expenses of \$439,160. Our building fund paid \$246,600 for building repairs and accessibility upgrading.

2024 COLLECTIONS UPDATE

Our parish Mass collections budget for this year is \$408,000, to help meet our expected expenses and "break even" for the year.

We are full of gratitude that Holy Rosary parishioners and visitors generously gave \$358,000 over the first 11 months of the year. We would have needed an additional \$16,000 to meet our Mass collections budget for that time period.

SOCIAL JUSTICE – ADVENT 2024

A few weeks ago, Bernadette asked me to tell a story about Climate Change. Forest fires, droughts, floods, melting permafrost & glaciers still seem far away from my life.

I am only one person. What could I possibly do? Yes, I recycle and reuse... the residents in my building collect SARCAN recyclables & we donate the \$'s to charity... I cut circles of plastic so an animal, (like the penguin in the movie "Happy Feet") won't get trapped by a piece of my garbage... I can afford paying the carbon tax in the hope of contributing to a change in fossil fuel consumption habits... I have a share in a Saskatoon Solar Co-operative... and last year, I gave up my car. Does any of this make a difference? God only knows... Living in the era of "white-privilege", in a Province that helped birth Co-operatives, Crowns and Medicare and with a unionized job at one of those Crowns for over 40 years, I continue to reap the benefits (pension-funded investments, good health, a home, family close by and a voice) while others, and the Earth, suffer. The Social Teachings of the Catholic Church, a faith I was lucky enough to be born into, has challenged me to ongoing conversion... God guides me... guides us... step by step... 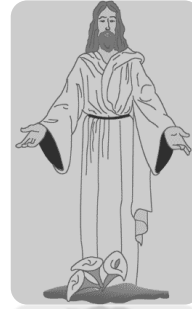

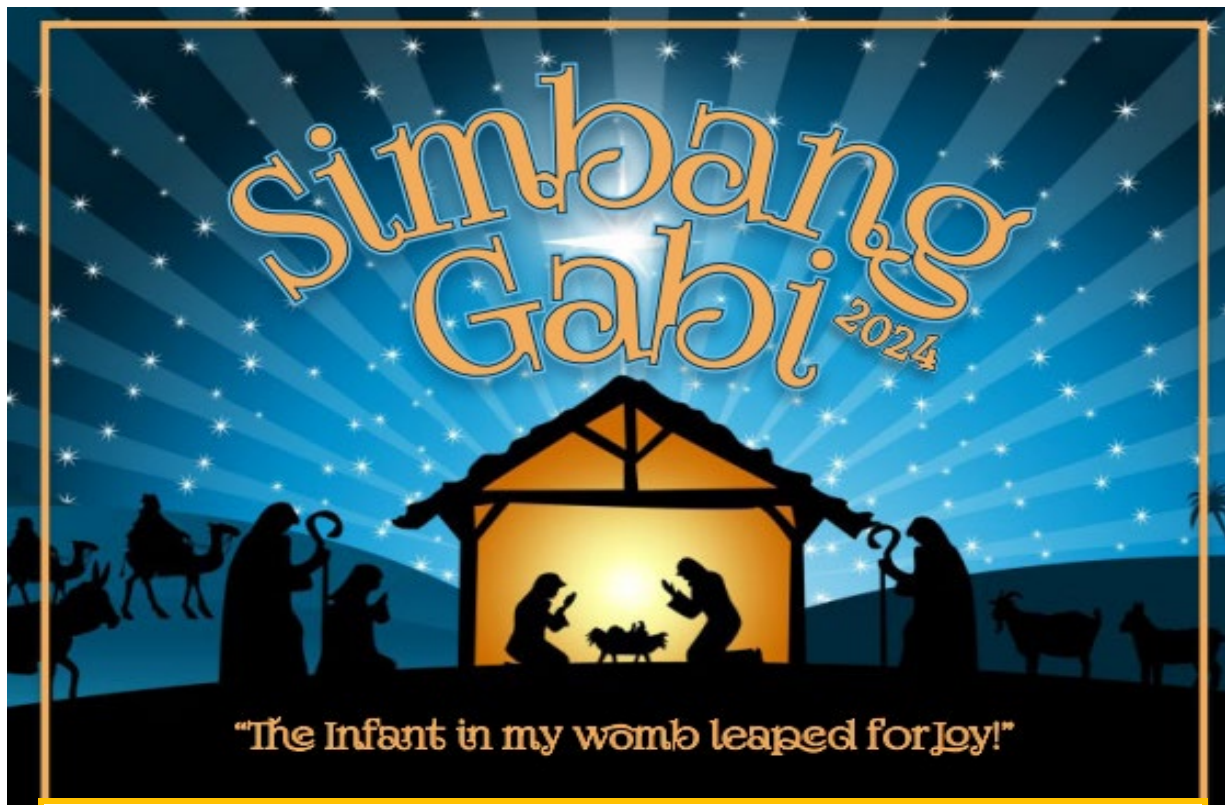

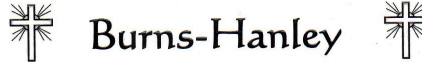
